Contest Description

TBA sponsor is sponsoring a contest whereby local artists are given an opportunity to submit designs for a woman's scarf and a man's necktie to assist in creating awareness of Community Services of Stark County, Inc. The winning designs will be chosen for manufacturing. Prizes will be structured as follows: \$1,000 for the tie design, \$1,000 for the scarf design, \$100 for (4) honorably mentioned designs.

Entrants must adhere to the following rules:

Eligibility

- Entrants must be legal U.S. residents or maintain a valid VISA.
- Community Services of Stark County, Inc. reserves the right to disqualify any entrant for any reason, including if it reasonably believes the entrant has breached any of these rules.
- Entrants must complete and submit the official entry form associated with the "Tie1On, Scarf1Up" contest along with their artwork by the deadline. No late entries will be accepted.

Subject Matter

- The design must be the submitting artist's original creation and may not be copied or duplicated in whole or in part from previously published art, including photographs, clipart or electronic graphic images.
- The contest theme is "Home." Artists are encouraged to submit designs related to "home" in recognition of Community Services of Stark County's "Giving Hope Since 1919" awareness efforts, but designs are not required to contain CSSC logo or colors.

Technical Requirements

- Entrants should illustrate their design to fill an area that is 8.5" x 11"; therefore the design may not necessarily be fit to scale for the finished scarf or necktie.
- Media can be any 2-dimensional format: watercolor; acrylic, computer generated, magic marker, pen and ink, etc.
- Your full name, address, phone, and e-mail must be included in the bottom right corner of your submission, separate from the art. This information must be legible.
- Exact specifications of the fabric, shape and dimensions of the scarf and necktie to be manufactured will be determined by the Tie1On Committee after the design is chosen.

Suitability for Reproduction

- Community Services of Stark County, Inc. and TBA sponsor reserve the right to alter the design if necessary for the manufacturing process. This includes redrawing, resetting type and changing colors.

Submission Procedures and Deadline

Date to begin entering submissions:

- Entrants may begin submitting their designs starting Friday, November 5, 2010. Must be submitted no later than Monday, January 31, 2011.

There are three approved methods for entering this contest:

- Walk-in entries must be received no later than 3:00 p.m. (EST), Monday, January 31, 2011 at Community Services of Stark County, Inc., 625 Cleveland Ave NW Canton, OH 44702. Entrants can drop off their design Monday-Friday between the hours of 9am-5pm. All entries should be in an envelope marked "Tie1On/Scarf1Up" contest. Drop-offs at any other location will not be accepted.
- Submissions (design and registration form) can be entered electronically by uploading the file at www.tie1.org. The entry must be a pdf or jpeg file in 300 dpi format and in a file size no larger than 5 MB, and your full name should be used as the file name, e.g. `fullname_scarfsubmission.jpg` and/or `fullname_tiesubmission.jpg`.

Electronic entries must be received by Community Services of Stark County, Inc. no later than 3:00 p.m. (EST), Monday, January 31, 2011.

- Mailed entries must be printed on 8.5" x 11" white paper with your full name within the 8.5" x 11" area. Entries can be mailed to "Tie1On/Scarf1Up" Design Contest c/o Community Services of Stark County, Inc., 625 Cleveland Ave NW Canton, OH 44702. Mailed entries must be post-marked no later than Monday, January 31, 2011.
- All entries should include the artist's name, address, phone number and email.
- Entries will not be returned and will become the property of Community Services of Stark County, Inc.

Prizes

- Prizes to be awarded: \$1,000 for the Tie Winner, \$1,000 for the Scarf Winner, and \$100 for (4) honorably mentioned. Prizes are non-transferable.
- All taxes are the sole responsibility of the prize winners.
- Prize winners will be notified by February 28, 2011, with prizes awarded at June 25th Gala. Return of any prize notification as undeliverable or failure to reply as specified in the notification within the time stated therein may result in disqualification of the initially selected winner and necessitate selection of an alternate winner. If a potential winner cannot be reached after a reasonable effort has been made during five business days from the first notification attempt, such person may be disqualified and an alternate winner selected.
- Winners will be required to sign and return an affidavit of eligibility/release and liability/publicity release. In the sole discretion of the Tie1On Committee, contest winner names and likenesses (including photo and design) may be published on the website and in associated marketing materials.

Liability

- Each entrant agrees to release and hold harmless sponsor, subsidiaries, affiliates, prize suppliers, advertising and promotion agencies, and each of their respective directors, officers, employees, shareholders and agents (collectively "releasees") from any and all liability or any injuries, loss or damage of any kind arising from or in connection with the contest or the acceptance or use of any prize.
- The Tie1On Committee makes no representations or warranties of any kind, express or implied, regarding any prize or entrant's participation in the contest. Neither Community Services of Stark County, Inc. nor any releases are responsible for: (i) technical or event failures of any kind, including but not limited to the malfunctioning of any computer, cable, network, hardware or software, delay in operation or transmission, communications line failure, technology outage, theft or destruction or unauthorized access to, or alteration of entries, whether caused by the sender or any of the equipment or programming associated with or utilized in the contest; (ii) unauthorized human intervention in any part of the entry process or the contest; (iii) electronic or human error that may occur in the administration of the contest or the processing of entries; (iv) cancellation or modification of the event or; (v) any injury

or damage to persons or property that may be caused, directly or indirectly, in whole or in part, by the entrant's participation in the contest or use of any prize.

Failure to Comply with Contest Rules

- Any entry that fails to comply with any of the requirements of the contest shall be disqualified and will not be considered by the judging panel.

Judging of the Contest

- Judging consists of a selected panel. The judges will be selected to provide a representative cross-section of individuals with expertise in design and/or an interest in Community Services of Stark County, Inc. Judging of the contest will take place in February 2011, with winners to be notified by February 28, 2011.

Intellectual Property Rights

- Each entrant transfers all copyright ownership of the submitted work to the Community Services of Stark County, Inc., including but not limited to the right to sublicense, to reproduce, distribute, use, exploit, transmit, create derivative works of, publicly display and publicly perform any entries (including, without limitation, ideas for new or improved products or services), by all means and in any media now known or hereafter developed. All entries must be original art with all rights to transfer.
